Visa & Health Insurance	
Contact person(s) responsible for visa:	<p>International guest students from the European Union countries, EEA and Switzerland do not need a visa to enter Germany.</p> <p>International guest students from Australia, Brazil, Canada, Israel, Japan, Republic of Korea, New Zealand and the USA can enter Germany for study purposes without a visa.</p>

Health insurance	<p>In order to study in Germany students need to have health insurance.</p> <p>Students from EU-Countries, Switzerland and Norway are covered by their home health insurance and need to bring their European Union Health Insurance Card, an E128 form or their national health insurance card.</p> <p>Students from Non-EU countries must register for German health insurance for the full semester (September – February or March – August). This insurance covers travel to other countries but does not cover repatriation. Application forms are included in the application process in Mobility Online.</p>
